Abase = to humiliate, degrade:

He had to abase himself before his boss to keep his job.

Abate = to become less strong:

We waited for Hurricane Irma to abate.

Abdicate = to fail or refuse to perform a duty:

The government was accused of abdicating its responsibility.

Abduct = to kidnap:

The diplomat was abducted on his way to the airport.

Aberration = something that differs from what's normal:

For her, such a low grade on an exam was an aberration.

Abet = to help someone do something wrong or illegal:

She abetted the thief in his getaway.

Abhor = to hate, dislike: We abhor dishonesty in any form.
